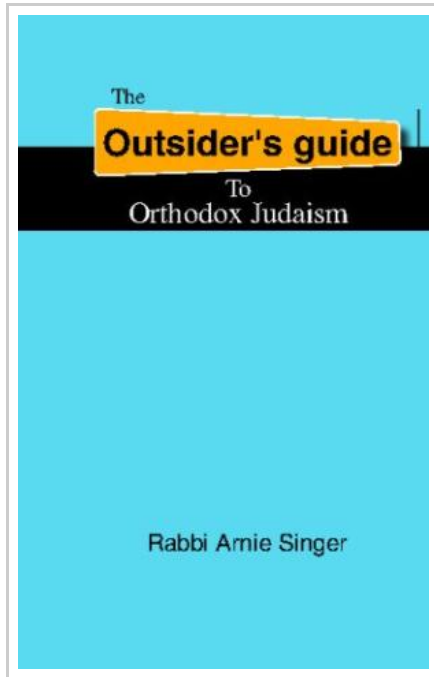




The Outsiders Guide To Orthodox Judaism
