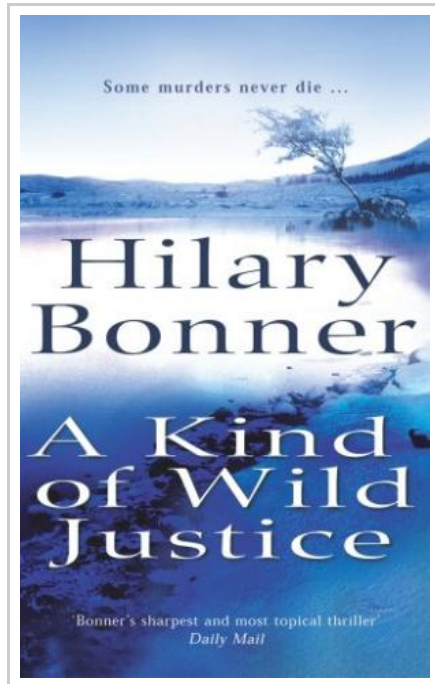




A Kind of Wild Justice
