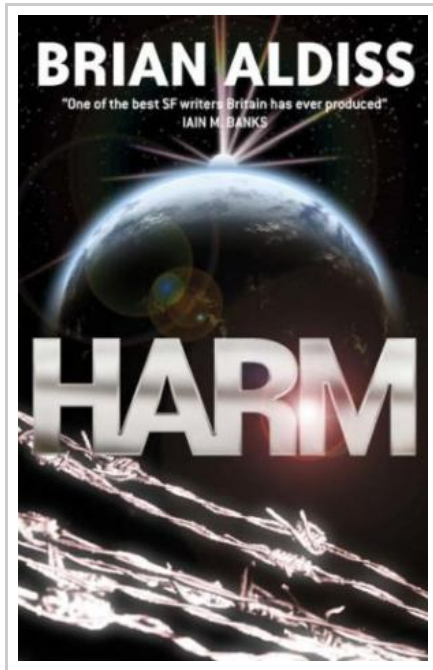




Harm
