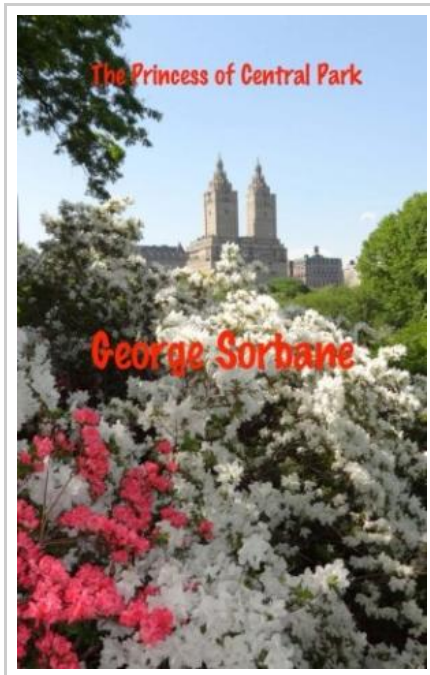




The Princess of Central Park
