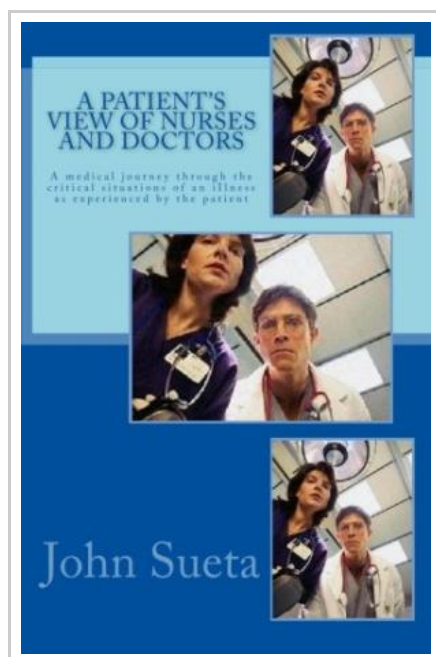




A Patient's View of Nurses and Doctors: A Medical Journey Through the Critical Situations of an Illness as Experienced by the Patient (Paperback)
