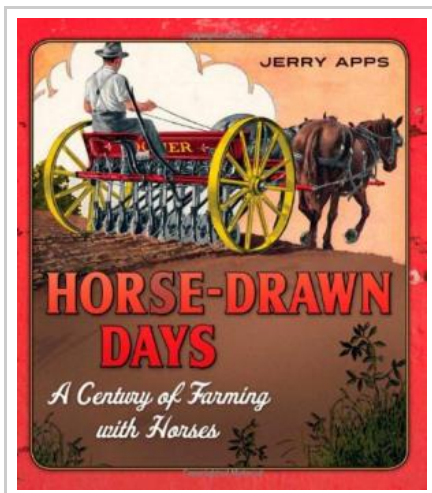




Horse-Drawn Days: A Century of Farming with Horses (Paperback)
