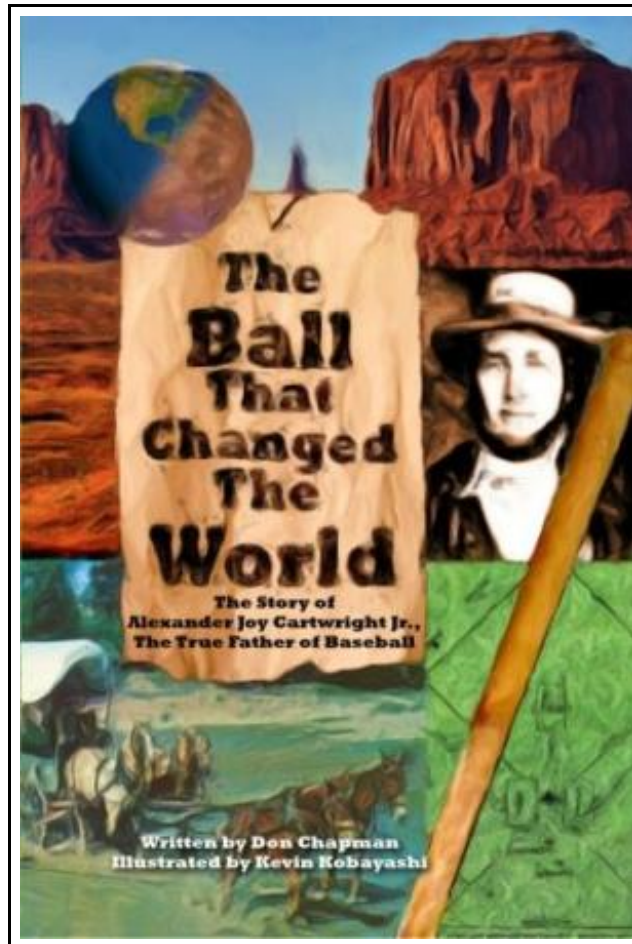


The Ball That Changed the World: The Story of Alexander Joy Cartwright Jr., True Father of Baseball (Paperback)
