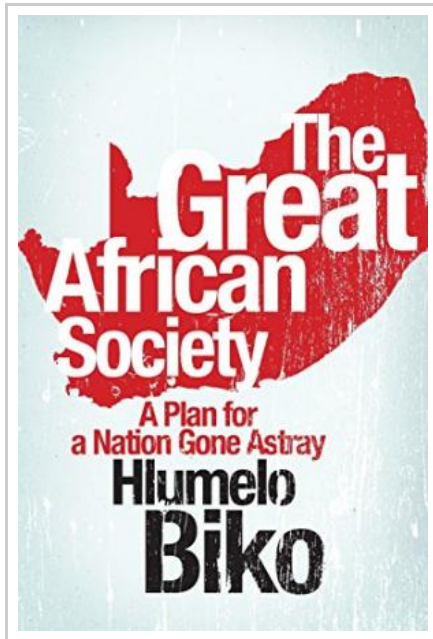




The Great African Society (Paperback)
